New Hanover County Democratic Party Opposes Senate Bill 20

With this dangerous and misleading anti-choice legislation, Republicans are one step closer to turning bipartisan North Carolina into MAGA-led Florida – but without cruises or the Magic Kingdom. **The NHCDP strongly opposes Senate Bill 20 and stands firmly with women, their reproductive freedom, and their access to safe and affordable healthcare.**

We recognize the incredibly complex and often-difficult circumstances that lead to abortion, a private decision that should be based upon sound medical advice, not extremist political demands. We believe that a woman should have the freedom to make personal choices about her body, not an overreaching and out-of-touch state government. Particularly not one led by politicians who have [repeatedly misled voters](#) about this very issue, from Rep. Ted Davis Jr. to Rep. Tricia Cotham.

Every [recent poll](#) shows that a majority of North Carolinians identify as pro-choice and support the right to abortion, even those surveys commissioned by right-wing organizations. This includes 59% of independent voters who want to keep or expand the current 20-week law. Facts matter. And it is clear that Senate Bill 20 is a blatant betrayal to voters across the state, which will have severe consequences for women everywhere.

Instead of a partisan power grab, the NHCDP urges our elected officials to protect women and vote against this antiquated policy. We promise to always fight for and with women, and we invite everyone, regardless of political party, to join our upcoming statewide day of action in opposition to Senate Bill 20 on May 21st.
